



Completing the *FAFSA*

Items you will need to complete your *FAFSA*

You will need records of income for the year prior to when you will start school. **You may also need records of your parent's income information if you are a dependent student.**

For example, for the 2002-2003 school year, you will need financial information from 2001.

- Your Social Security Number (can be found on Social Security card)
- Your driver's license (if any)
- Your parent's Social Security Number, if you are dependent.
- Your income tax return - IRS Form 1040, 1040A, 1040EZ, 1040Telefile, foreign tax return, or tax return for Puerto Rico, Guam, American Samoa, the U.S. Virgin Islands, the Marshall Islands, the Federated States of Micronesia
- Your parent's income tax return (if you are a dependent student)
- Your W-2 forms
- Your parent's W-2 forms, if you are dependent.
- Your 2001 untaxed income records - Social Security, Temporary Assistance to Needy Families (TANF), welfare, or veteran's benefits
- Your 2001 bank statements.
- Your 2001 business and investment mortgage information, business and farm records, stock, bond, and other investment records, if applicable
- Your alien registration card (if you are not a U.S. citizen)
